1.0. Submission of Applications

- 1.1. Applications should be submitted to Gweru Polytechnic, Registry Office. Admission will be on a first-come first served basis.

2.0. Minimum Entry Qualifications

- 2.1. For all National Certificate (NC) courses:
 Five (5) Ordinary Levels, with Grade C or better including English Language.
 For Business Studies and Information Technology, 'O' Level Mathematics is a requirement.
 For Engineering disciplines, a Science subject and Mathematics at 'O' level are required. Relevant NFC subjects will be considered.
- 2.2. For National Diploma (ND) and Higher National Diploma (HND), applicants must possess the relevant NC and ND respectively.
- 2.3. For ND in Technical and Vocational Education (HEXCO), applicants must possess ND or equivalent, NC plus Class One Journeyman Certificate (for Engineering) in area of specialization.

3.0. Documents Required

- 3.1. An application form obtainable from the Gweru Polytechnic website (www.gwerupoly.ac.zw). The form is also available from Gweru Polytechnic.
- 3.2. Original certificates plus two (2) sets of certified copies of birth certificate, national ID and academic and/or professional certificates
- 4.0. Handling Fees: All applicants will pay a non-refundable handling fee of US\$15 or equivalent. Proof of payment is required on submission of the application.
